Copyright Permission

Materials are made available for course reserves under four common conditions:

- Materials will be used under the provision of Fair Use (U.S. Copyright Act, 17 U.S. Code Section 107), as outlined in the Classroom Guidelines or as determined using a case-by-case four-factor analysis

Instructors are responsible for evaluating, on a case-by-case basis, whether the use of a copyrighted work requires permission or qualifies as fair use. When permissions are needed, instructors or their departments are expected to make any required arrangements. University Libraries will provide consultation and assistance to instructors in qualifying any specific use as fair use.

Course Restriction

Electronic reserve courses require course-level password authentication. Distribution of the password is limited to students enrolled in the course. Password protection creates a secure environment for access to copyrighted works that allows University Libraries to make materials available to students under the provisions of fair use. Limiting access to students who are registered in your class helps assure that materials are used only for educational purposes and minimizes any impact on the market for the original work. This restriction is essential to a good faith assertion of fair use in electronic reserves service.
